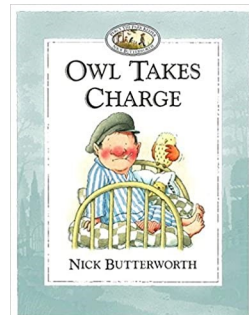
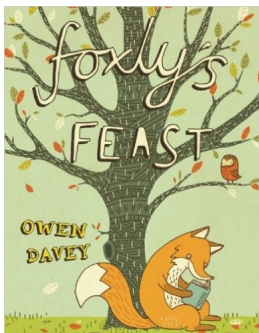
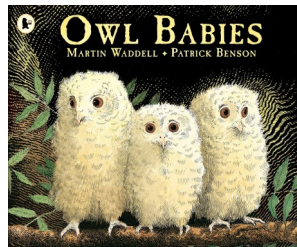
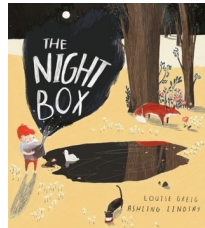
We will be learning about nocturnal animals and their habitats.
