I hope you have all seen the information sent home yesterday about Forest School. These sessions will be up and running from next week for year 1 and 2 children. Thank you for your patience as we worked out how to staff these sessions. We know how valuable these sessions are for children to enhance their learning experience. It has been a challenge to find a suitable alternative to staffing since Easter and Wild Explorer enabled us to keep the outdoor learning going during the summer term, but we didn't have the trained leader to officially call it Forest School. I am very excited to now be able to offer the Forest School sessions with a trained leader and therefore a fire! As you all know this week we were inspected by Ofsted. You will know from recent media coverage Ofsted has made some changes to the way they inspect schools, and I am happy to say our inspector really did look after all the staff's well-being during the inspection to make it as pleasant an experience as it could be. I wanted to thank you all for your kindness and support over the past few days and for completing the parent survey. As a school we want to build on our recognitions for children who try the best in class and show kindness at all times to others. This week we have introduced positive notes which will be used by any adult at school to celebrate achievements. These will be given to children to bring home. Please join us in really celebrating these with your child, and make a big fuss about these as we do in school.

Our 'recognition boards' are having a really positive impact on children and are being used to teach children about the behaviours we are expecting them to show during learning. This is the opposite to an older approach of names being written on a board for negative behaviours and is all about 'flipping the script' for children as we recognise the positive behaviours over the negative ones.

Please be assured that this does not mean the negative behaviours are not being dealt with. We have very high expectations for behaviour which was picked up by the Ofsted inspection, and know children need clear and consistent rules and boundaries. As we review our behaviour policy this term, we will be seeking parent's views. We will soon be sending a copy of the behaviour policy home for your comments.
