Dear Parents/Carers,

Where is the time going! With Christmas fast approaching please check you know all the dates for different events in school, the dates are in the calendar below. Details of the Disco will be sent out next week. We have also added the 'Party Day' on Thursday 14th December, children can wear party clothes to school on this day.

As you know we have reviewed and made some changes to our school behaviour policy. We would really value parent feedback on this before it is finalised. Please see attached our draft new policy. The main changes are:

- We now have 3 consistent behaviour values—Ready, Respectful, Safe
- The focus is more on recognising positive behaviour as much as possible to really promote the expected behaviour
- The rainbow has been replaced with a variety of positive approaches including positive notes, headteacher notes, celebration assembly, and hot chocolate Friday which is half termly. We also use a board in the classroom to notice and praise the children using the right learning behaviour.
- The raincloud which was previously used as a 'formal consequence' for negative behaviour has been replaced with a 'restorative approach' which follows a set of steps to support children to think and learn about how their behaviour affects other. Staff will support children with this. This approach is used across many schools and is proven to effectively support behaviour with children.

At the end of last half term we had our first 'Hot Chocolate Friday' which will become an end of half term treat for chosen children. The children chosen for this are those who always do the right thing and always show our behaviour values Ready, Respectful, Safe.
